“Città diffusa“, “Zwischenstadt“, “Plankton City”... As the discourse on the urban periphery grows – its charms and mysteries being more and more discussed, examined, partially disclosed, Berlin remains a very specific case. In a city that through the Wall-division multiplied border situations as well as reinforced its already strong, historically developed centers, the housing question applied to the so-called “Außenstadt” requires specific and subtle answers – ones that are rooted in Berlin’s multilayered/multi-centered reality. The edge between Berlin and Brandenburg entails many of these special, if not bizarre, situations i.e. transitions to a wide/wild landscape. What *artefacts* are to be found? How do trees look like? How do (or did), conflicting legislations between different administrative entities leave their mark on the territory? Are there secret booming spots? Derelict neighborhoods?

Task:

Explore the Berlin-Brandenburg border (by foot; on a map) and select a 200x200m fragment for an intervention of your choice. The intervention can be of an architectural nature or concern the landscape. It can also describe a simple event, that underlines certain qualities or lifestyles only to be found within urban peripheries.

Representation in axonometry and collage.

> Axonometry

Line-drawing (!!!), existing in black & white, intervention in one color

Digital or hand-drawn

Scale 1/500 – „bubbled“ zooms within the drawing are allowed

Format 40x40cm (use Template!!! > on the upper left corner – locate the chosen site with a black dot on the reduced Berlin map)

> Collage

Collage upper part (8,5x13cm - color) - Frontal view, existing situation

Collage lower part (8,5x13cm - color) - Frontal view, intervention identifiable

A 3 minutes oral description will allow you to describe both the intervention & chosen site on Fr. 12.10.

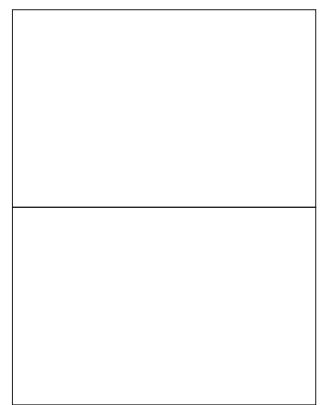
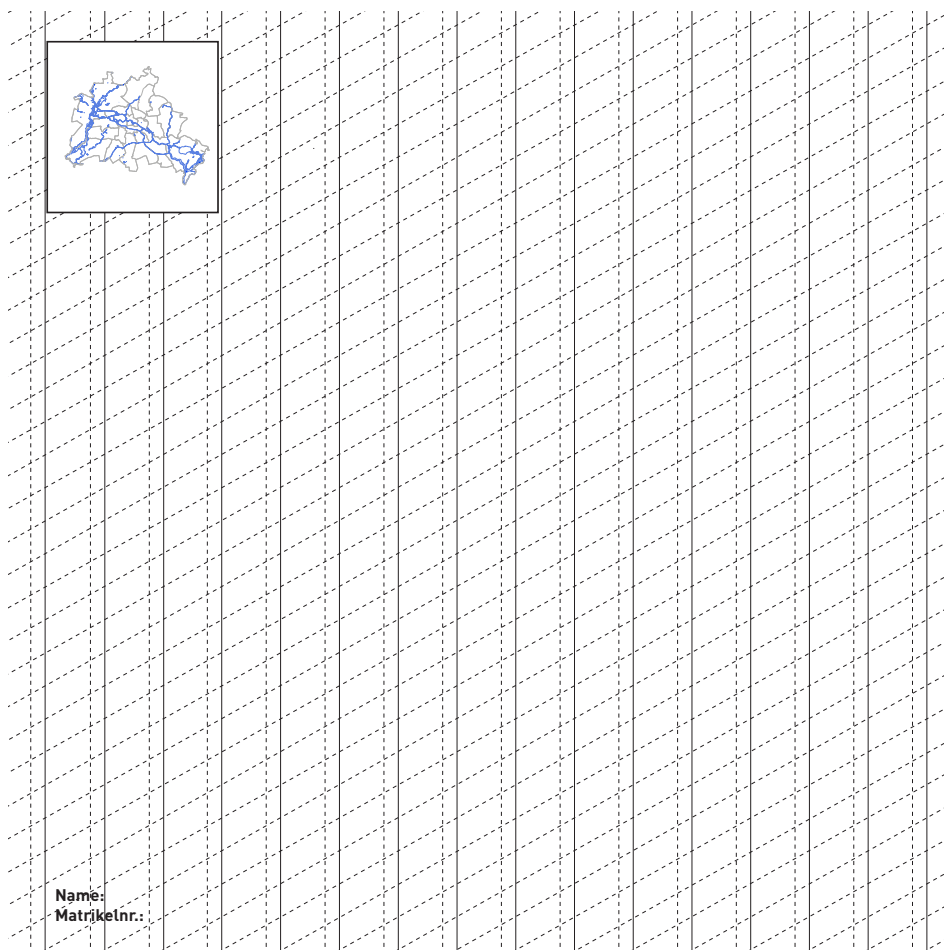
